The last week's Bible Class lessons (before Easter Sunday and our Spring Break) were focused on the sufferings of Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane, His crucifixion, death, burial, resurrection and His ascension. When classes resume, we will begin focusing on "what came next" for His disciples as their Lord and Savior was not visibly present now. We will begin with the account of Peter, having just been questioned by Jesus about his love for Him and being told pretty straightforwardly that he was going to glorify God by suffering for Him. Peter quickly turns the attention off of himself and asks the Lord what was going to happen to John - maybe to compare if they would have similar fates! Two times in a short series of verses, Jesus tells Peter to "Follow Me!" As our Creator, Lord and Savior, He has the supreme authority to command our obedience to go where He directs us to go and do what He requires of us, albeit at times, with suffering being the venue through which our lives will best bring glory to Him!

Shortly after the answer was given, he asked Jesus into his life, and he made others aware of what happened. There have been comments that there are noticeable differences in his young life!
